Quotes from Greek odes in Acts 17:28	
<i>For in him we live and move and have our being.</i>	A grave have [they] fashioned for thee, O holy and high One, the lying Cretans, who are all the time liars, evil beasts, idle bellies; but thou diest not, for to eternity thou livest and standest; for in thee we live, and move, and have our being. (Epimenides, Cretica)
<i>We are his offspring.</i>	Let us begin with Zeus. Never, O men, let us leave him unmentioned. All the ways are full of Zeus, and all the market-places of human being. The sea is full. Of him; so are the harbors. In every way we have all to do with Zeus, For we are truly his offspring." (Aratus, c. 310 BCE)
